

Microfiber Fabric Care Guide

Caring for Your Upholstered Furniture

Thank you for choosing our furniture. Your upholstery is covered in high-quality microfiber fabric, known for its soft feel, durability, and resistance to everyday wear. With proper care, your furniture will remain comfortable and beautiful for years to come.

Routine Cleaning

Regular maintenance helps keep your furniture looking fresh.

- Vacuum weekly using a soft brush upholstery attachment.
 - Remove dust, crumbs, and pet hair regularly.
 - Brush the fabric gently with a soft upholstery brush to maintain its texture.
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Cleaning Spills

Act quickly to prevent stains from setting.

1. Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry, white cloth.
 2. Do not rub the stain, as this may spread it deeper into the fabric.
 3. Continue blotting until most of the moisture has been absorbed.
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Spot Cleaning

For most water-safe microfiber fabrics:

- Use a small amount of mild dish soap mixed with warm water.
- Dampen a clean microfiber cloth—never soak the fabric.
- Gently blot the affected area from the outside toward the center.
- Wipe away any soap residue with a clean, damp cloth.
- Allow the fabric to air dry completely.
- Once dry, lightly brush the fabric to restore its original texture.

Always test any cleaning solution on an inconspicuous area before treating visible surfaces.

Solvent-Cleaning Fabrics

Some microfiber fabrics carry a "S" or "S/W" cleaning code.

If your furniture includes one of these fabrics:

- Follow the cleaning code provided on the manufacturer's label.
 - Use only approved upholstery cleaning products designed for your fabric type.
 - If unsure, consult a professional upholstery cleaner.
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Protect Your Furniture

To extend the life of your upholstery:

- Rotate seat and back cushions regularly when applicable.
 - Avoid sitting on the arms or back of the furniture.
 - Keep sharp objects away from the fabric.
 - Use throws or blankets in high-use areas if desired.
 - Keep pet nails trimmed to reduce snagging.
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Avoid Excess Moisture

Microfiber dries quickly but should never become saturated.

Do **not**:

- Soak the fabric with water.
- Use steam cleaners unless specifically approved by the manufacturer.
- Allow moisture to remain trapped in cushions.

Always allow upholstery to dry completely before use.

Sunlight Exposure

Extended exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading over time.

For best results:

- Keep furniture out of prolonged direct sunlight.
 - Use curtains or blinds in bright rooms.
 - Rotate cushions periodically to promote even wear and fading.
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Avoid Harsh Chemicals

Do **not** use:

- Bleach
- Ammonia
- Acetone
- Paint thinner
- Strong solvents (unless specifically recommended for "S" fabrics)
- Abrasive brushes or scouring pads

These products may permanently damage the fibers or alter the fabric's color and texture.

Pet Care

Microfiber is naturally resistant to pet hair, making cleanup easy.

For best results:

- Vacuum pet hair regularly.
 - Remove stubborn hair using a lint roller or slightly damp rubber glove.
 - Address accidents immediately to prevent staining or odors.
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Professional Cleaning

For large stains, persistent odors, or heavy soiling, professional upholstery cleaning is recommended.

Periodic professional cleaning can help extend the life and appearance of your furniture.
